## Price:

Daily, 9am-12pm: \$33 per child per day

Monthly, 1xweek: \$120 per child

\*All campers will be charged a non-refundable annual administration fee of \$35 at the time of registration.

## Frequently Asked Questions:

**Q: What should my child bring?**

A: Children should come dressed in comfortable, season appropriate clothing that can get dirty since some activities we do on a daily basis are messy. A spare change of clothes is required for all children in case of soiling of clothes. Children under the age of 3, and those who are potty-training require at least two changes of clothing (including socks). We want to keep your child happy and comfortable!

**Q: What is your bathroom policy?**

A: We do accept children who are 2 years old in diapers and we are happy to help you and your child with the toilet training process; however **for the health and safety of children, parents or legal guardians are responsible for changing their child's diapers.** When your child is potty-training, it is essential that your child be dressed in "user-friendly" clothing. We will do our best to work with your child and let you know how they are doing each day.

**Q: What is the drop-off/pick-up procedure?**

A: Parents will drop-off and pick-up their children in our camp room on the second floor. An adult **MUST** sign the child in and out of camp every day. Please notify the Director when someone other than the parents or guardians will be picking up your child, an Authorization Drop-off/Pick-up form must be filled out.

**Q: Will snack or lunch be provided?**

A: Flying High will provide a daily snack. Snacks will include Cheez-Its, Goldfish crackers, Animal crackers, and Chex Mix. We will make accommodations for children requiring a special diet when able and when not able, we will ask the parents/guardians to provide an appropriate snack for their child.
